



THE VUORI-KALAJA ACCESSIBLE ROUTE, 300 m

Start & Finish:

you can take your own car or a wheelchair taxi to the Vuori-Kalaja parking lot, but there's a gate in the beginning of the Vuori-Kalaja forest road. Handicapped users can ask for the key to the gate from Törmälä Holiday and Course Centre (www.tormala.fi, Konnekoskentie 552, Rautalampi). Please note that you might need assistance to open the gate.

Suitability:

wheelchair route, with assistance

Duration:

when there's no snow and ice on the ground, about 30 minutes

Facilities:

accessible lean-to/hut, campfire site and accessible outdoor toilet on the shore of Vuori-Kalaja Pond. Please bring your own toilet paper.

Things to see:

clear Vuori-Kalaja Pond and majestic landscape.

Fall in love with the spectacular scenery of the Vuori-Kalaja Pond, and have a time to remember amidst the most beautiful nature. There's a circular, accessible trail of about 300 metres, starting from the Vuori-Kalaja parking lot. You will need assistance because of the differences in elevation. The trail runs partly on a gravelled path, partly on a wide causeway and partly on the Vuori-Kalaja forest road. There is an observation deck along the trail, right by the beach. There is an access to the campfire site and the lean-to/hut.

Things to note:

- There's a row boat at the customers' disposal by the beach. Please bring your own life jacket.
- You can reach the accessible trail from the Kalaja parking lot, following the connecting trail of about 1 km to Vuori-Kalaja. The trail is relatively easy with small changes in elevation, but not accessible.

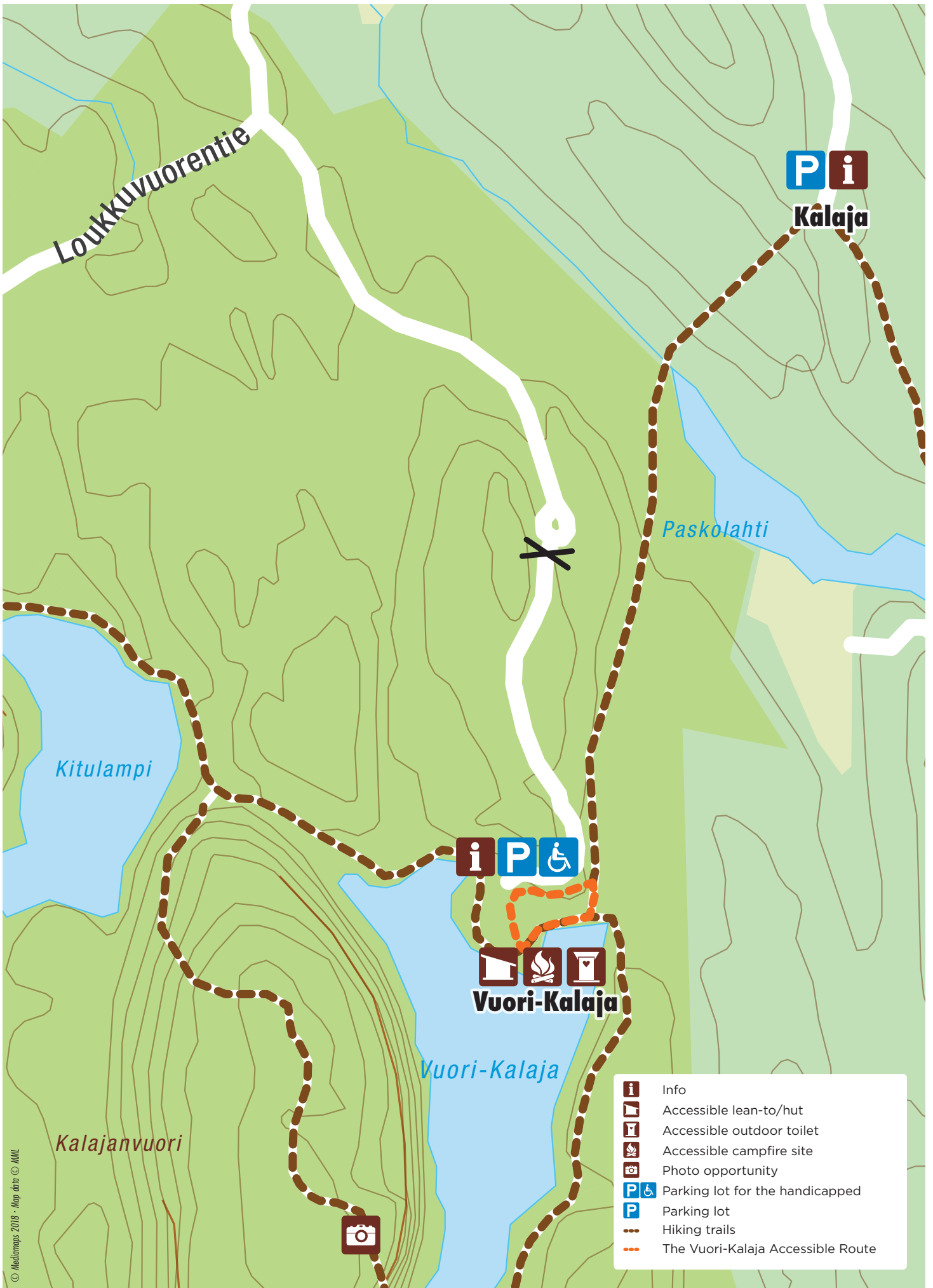
